

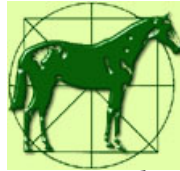

New Zealand Equine Research Foundation Scholarship

The foundation was established by combined Committee comprising representatives of the New Zealand Racing Conference, Harness Racing New Zealand, New Zealand Thoroughbred Breeders Association, New Zealand Standardbred Breeders Association, with advisors from Massey University and Lincoln College, in 1976. It became incorporated as a Board in 1981 under the provisions of the Charitable Trusts Act 1957.

This Scholarship shall be available to New Zealand Citizens studying full time in veterinary science. Applications will be accepted by BVSc fourth year students and will be awarded at the beginning of their final year in March. Criteria for assessment will include academic record, curriculum vitae, referee reports, application essay and demonstration of a particular interest in horses. Financial need is not a major criterion but may be taken into account in awarding the scholarship.

The Scholarship shall be awarded annually and shall have a value of \$5,000.

The Selection Committee may refrain from making the award if there is not an applicant of sufficient merit.

The Scholarship may be held in conjunction with other awards/scholarships.

The Scholarship shall be awarded by the University Council on the recommendation of a selection panel from The NZ Equine Research Foundation and Massey University.

Applicants are to complete the application form and are to attach:

- A short essay (500 words) on why you want to work in the equine industry including why you deserve to be awarded this scholarship
- Curriculum Vitae together with the names and addresses of three referees with current knowledge of your activities. One of these referees must be an academic staff member teaching in the BVSc course.
- A copy of your Academic Transcript from your BVSc degree

Applicants are requested to supply **four** completed sets of their application form and attachments by the closing date of 24th November 2008, the year preceding that in which the award is made.
